- 3. **Behavior.** Scouts are expected to abide by, and behave in accordance with, the Scout Oath, Scout Law, and the Youth Protection Guidelines, at all times, while in attendance at the Jamboree. Non-compliance may result in Scout's expulsion from the Jamboree.
- 4. **Equipment.** The Moraine Trails Council will provide one (1) tent for every two (2) Scouts attending the Jamboree. However, Scouts may be required to bring additional equipment such as eating utensils, clothing, uniforms, sleeping gear, etc. In the event that Scout is required to bring additional equipment to the Jamboree, Parent/Guardian hereby agrees that the Moraine Trails Council is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged property.
- 5. **Indemnification.** Parent/Guardian hereby expressly agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Moraine Trails Council, its elected and appointed officials, employees, agents, successors, grantees or assigns against all suits, causes of actions, claims, complaints, obligations, charges, debts, losses, demands, expenses (including all expenses of litigation, court costs and attorney's fees), damages, and/or claims of any kind whatsoever, whether in law or in equity, direct, known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, for injury to or death of any person or for damage to any property or any other damages arising from or in direct connection with the Jamboree.
- 6. **Release/ Hold Harmless.** Parent/Guardian understands that participation in Scouting activities involves the risk of personal injury, including death, due to the physical, mental, and emotional challenges in the activities offered. Information about those activities may be obtained from the venue, activity coordinators, or local council. Parent/Guardian also understands that participation in these activities is entirely voluntary and requires participants to follow instructions and abide by all applicable rules and the standards of conduct.
 - In case of an emergency involving Scout, Parent/Guardian understands that a. every effort will be made to contact them. In the event Parent/Guardian cannot be reached, permission is hereby given to the medical provider, selected by the adult leader in charge, to secure proper treatment, including hospitalization, anesthesia, surgery, or injections of medication for Scout. Medical providers are authorized to disclose protected health information to the adult in charge and/or any physician or health care provider involved in providing medical care to the participant. Protected Health Information/Confidential Health Information (PHI/CHI) under the Standards for Privacy of Individually Identifiable Health Information, 45 C.F.R. §§ 160.103, 164.501, et. seq., as amended from time to time, includes examination findings, test results, and treatment provided for purposes of medical evaluation of the participant, follow-up and communication with the participant's parents or guardian, and/or determination of the participant's ability to continue in the program activities.
 - b. With appreciation of the dangers and risks associated with programs and activities including preparations for and transportation to and from the Jamboree, Parent/Guardian, on behalf of themselves and Scout, hereby fully and completely release and waive any and all claims for personal injury, death or loss that may arise against the Boy Scouts of America, the local council (Moraine Trails Council), the activity

coordinators, and all employees, volunteers, related parties, or other organizations associated with any program or activity.

- 7. **Binding Nature of Release.** The Release contained in Paragraph Six herein shall be binding upon Parent/Guardian, their heirs, personal representatives, successors, and assigns.
- 8. **Reservation of Rights.** The Moraine Trails Council reserves the following rights that it may exercise in its sole discretion: (i) the right to cancel the trip; and (ii) the right to make alterations, changes, and modifications in any part of the trip itinerary and the activities related thereto.
- 9. **Partial Invalidity.** If any term or provision of this Agreement shall be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, unenforceable, or in conflict with any law governing this Agreement, then the parties agree that all remaining terms and provisions shall not be affected thereby.
- 10. **Governing Law.** This agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
